'REMOVAL OF TRASH FROM CITY TRASH RECEPTACLES
PROHIBITED', MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR OTHER THAN
CITY EMPLOYEES OR CITY CONTRACTORS TO SORT OR
REMOVE TRASH FROM CITY TRASH RECEPTACLES:
DECLARING A VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE TO
BE A MISDEMEANOR AND PROVIDING A PENALTY UPON
CONVICTION THEREOF: PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE, AND
PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Ordinances set forth below would be in
the best interest of the citizens of Wheeler, Texas, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WHEELER, TEXAS:

ARTICLE VI

REMOVAL OF TRASH FROM CITY TRASH RECEPTACLES PROHIBITED

Section 8-15

No person, other than an employee or contractor of the City of Wheeler in the performance of
duties assigned by the City of Wheeler, shall sort or remove trash from trash receptacles owned or
provided by the City of Wheeler.

Section 8-16

Any person, firm, or corporation who violates the provisions of this Article is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more than \$200.00. Each and every act constitutes a violation of this Article shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.
